*The first vintage Champagne to be bottled in a mini bottle. Floral nose combines with touches of citrus finishing in a silky cocoon.*
- Duval-Leroy Sec Champagne "Lady Rose" (375ml) // France NV** **55**  
*Off-dry rosé, full of cherry, berry, spice and pastry flavors married to a fine mousse.*
- Pommery Royal Brut Champagne // France NV** **80**  
*Broad and inviting, exhibiting peach, honey and spice flavors. This is creamy and, though balanced on the soft side. **89 WS.***
- Argyle "Extended Tirage" // Willamette Valley, Oregon 1999** **140**  
*Elegant, with very fine bubbles and complex spice, coffee, pear and toast aromas and flavors. **95 WS.***
- Moet Chandon Dom Perignon Champagne // France 2000** **185**  
*Toasty aromas meld into freshly cut flowers, apricots and pears, with sweet notes of mint and licorice that linger. **94 WS.***

## RIESLING

- Marcus Molitor Haus Klosterberg Spatlese // Mosel, Germany 2008** **60**  
*Slate, white peach and apple aromas, along with the "cool" black currant predominant in the vintage. **92 WS.***
- Dr. Loosen Wehlener Sonnenuhr Kabinett // Mosel, Germany 2007** **65**  
*Lime, grapefruit and peach flavors with an undercurrent of mineral. It's balanced and has a crisp, tangy aftertaste. **91 WS.***
- Rolly Gassmann Kappelweg // Alsace, France 2004** **99**  
*Lilies, mint, and black currant in the nose, leading to refined and subtly-sweet, chalky finish with hints of refreshing lemon.*

## PINOT GRIGIO and PINOT GRIS

- Adelsheim Pinot Gris // Willamette Valley, Oregon 2008** 30  
*Bosc pear, peach and apple flavors dominate the fruit profile, with a bit of spiciness.*
- Au Bon Climat Pinot Gris/Pinot Blanc // Santa Barbara County, California 2007** 40  
*Zippy, fresh-fruit acidity that is matched by plenty of apple, pear, grapefruit, and pineapple.*
- King Estate Domaine Pinot Gris // Oregon 2007** 60  
*Aromas of tropical fruit, tangerine, and a floral perfume. Rich and enticing with light citrus and bright fruit flavors. 90 WS*
- Jermann Pinot Grigio // Venezia-Giulia, Italy 2007** 78  
*Clean and fruity, with apple, melon and banana aromas. Medium-bodied, with good fruit.*
- Jermann Pinot Grigio // Venezia-Giulia, Italy 2008** 60  
*Tropical fruit aromas lead to a full body, with plenty of fruit and an orange peel and pie tart aftertaste.*

## SAUVIGNON BLANC

- Clifford Bay // Awatere Valley, New Zealand 2009** 28  
*Blackcurrant, guava and citrus notes. The palate exhibits the same fine fruit flavors with an under lying flinty note typical of Awatere Valley fruit. The finish is long, crisp and dry.*
- Merryvale // Napa Valley, California 2009** 30  
*Expressive notes of lemon, honeydew melon, alyssum flower, orange, honeysuckle and vanilla bean.*
- Daniel Chotard Sancerre // Loire Valley, France 2007** 60  
*Light, with modest lime, herb, and lemon notes.*
- Rudd // Napa Valley, California 2007** 70  
*Pronounced notes of honeyed melons, hints of figs and smoke, and a waxy orange-like character. 92 Parker.*
- Merry Edwards // Russian River Valley, California 2009** 90  
*Golden delicious and honey crisp apples accented with crème brûlée and sweet Meyer lemon.*

## VIOGNIER

- Domaine Gayda Vin de Pays d' Oc // Languedoc-Roussillon, France 2008** 35  
*Peach and apple flavors dominate this medium-bodied white.*
- Dumol "Lia" // Russian River Valley, California 2008** 125  
*Medium to full body, with fresh Lychee nut and tropical fruit notes. Good acidity as well as plenty of flavor intensity. 92 Parker.*
- E. Guigal Condrieu "La Doriane" // Loire Valley, France 2007** 160  
*White peach, fig, almond and melon notes carried by a remarkably creamy-textured palate. Long and pure through the finish. 94 WS.*

## CHARDONNAY

- Fess Parker, Ashley's Vineyard // Santa Rita Hills, California 2008** 65  
*Minerality and creaminess give shape and texture to the leesy, yeasty flavors of pineapples, key lime pie and ripe pear puree. 95 Enthusiast.*
- Mer Soleil // Central Coast, California 2007** 70  
*Combines ripe, intense peach, nectarine and tangerine fruit, with touches of floral and spice. Gains body and depth. 91 WS.*
- Patz and Hall // Sonoma Coast, California 2008** 70  
*Clean and vibrant, with a mix of spice, green apple, citrus and honeydew melon.*
- Brewer-Clifton // Santa Rita Hills, California 2007** 75  
*This is an elegant, crisp, restrained wine that really shows off how great cool-climate Chardonnay can be.*
- Jean-Marc Brocard Chablis 1er Fourchaume // Burgundy, France 2006** 75  
*Chalky minerality in a matrix of lemon, grapefruit, and pit fruits. 88 Parker.*
- Adobe Road, Bacigalupi Vineyard // Russian River Valley, California 2007** 80  
*Ripe pineapple, granny smith apple, and banana. The exploding entrance brings on a distinct minerality with flint and wet rock.*
- Mer Soleil "Silver" // Santa Lucia Highlands, California 2006** 80  
*Fresh and tangy, with vibrant peach, nectarine and citrus flavors that are clean and refreshing. Unoaked.*
- Pali, Shea Vineyard // Willamette Valley, Oregon 2008** 80  
*Aromas of wet stone, honeysuckle, fresh apple and pear, opening into steely grapefruit and lime, finishing with a hint of butterscotch.*
- Paul Hobbs "Crossbarn" // Sonoma Coast, California 2008** 80  
*Ripe pear, kiwi, and stone fruits, leading to a citrusy finish accented with orange blossom and balanced acidity.*
- Rodney Strong Reserve // Sonoma, California 2007** 90  
*Floral honeysuckle, ripe fig and melon scents are rich, full-bodied, elegant and refined. 93 WS.*
- Patz and Hall, Hyde Vineyard // Carneros, California 2007** 90  
*Orange marmalade, pineapple, honeysuckle, and candied fruit aromas jump from the glass of this elegant wine. 94 Parker.*
- Forman // Napa Valley, California 2006** 110  
*Classic lemon blossom, apple rind, nectarine, and striking minerality. 91 Parker.*
- Shafer, Red Shoulder Ranch // Napa / Carneros, California 2007** 115  
*Loads of tropical fruit, pear, and honeysuckle. The oak component has been downplayed over recent vintages. 92 Parker.*

- Domaine Gabriel et Paul Jouard Chassagne-Montrachet // Burgundy, France 2007** 115  
*Classic Chassagne exhibiting depth of green and yellow fruits and good spice.*
- Martinelli "Martinelli Road" // Russian River Valley, California 2006** 115  
*Aromas of wet river rocks, lemon zest, orange blossoms, poached pears, and a hint of subtle wood. Good acidity provides zip. 93 Parker.*
- Kistler "Les Noisetiers" // Sonoma Coast, California 2007** 125  
*Unfiltered and unfined Chardonnay from one of California's most consistent producers.*
- Far Niente // Napa Valley, California 2007** 125  
*Rich and layered green apple, pear, spice and nutmeg give this a tight focus. Full-bodied with a long, fruity finish. 91 WS.*
- Chasseur, Durell Vineyard // Sonoma Valley, California 2006** 130  
*Burgundian in style, this is firm, with toasty, buttery oak joining ripe apple and pear flavors. The oak gives this a spicy nutmeg scent. Ends on an elegant note, picking up a hint of marshmallow. 90 WS.*
- Martinelli, Three Sisters Vineyard // Sonoma Coast, California 2006** 135  
*Honeysuckle, wet stone, and leesy, waxy notes. Citrus fruits in its fresh, full-bodied personality. 94 Parker.*
- Newton "Unfiltered" // Napa Valley, California 2006** 135  
*Butter and oak with layers of peach, mango and honey and a touch of mineral on the finish. 96 Parker.*
- Pahlmeyer // Napa Valley, California 2006** 135  
*The core pear, apple, spice and citrus notes are fresh and vibrant, and the finish is long and persistent.*
- Jean-Marc Brocard Chablis Les Clos // Burgundy, France 2007** 140  
*Intense flinty, savory character signals this white's lemon, peach, yellow plum and mineral aromas and flavors. 95 WS.*
- Dumol "Chloe" // Russian River Valley, California 2007** 140  
*Subtle honey, white currants, white peaches, and hints of tropical fruit such as pineapple, as well as floral undertones. 96 Parker.*
- Domaine Leflaive Puligny Montrachet // Burgundy, France 200** 155  
*A ripe, opulent style, sporting apricot, butterscotch and spice flavors.*
- Domaine Francois et Jean Marie Raveneau Chablis Blanchots // Burgundy, France 2007** 225  
*Intensely saline and stony statement that finishes with an energetic crescendo of citrus and diverse expressions of things mineral. 95 Parker.*

## OTHER WHITES

- Touquinheiras Clemen, Reserva // Vinho Verde, Portugal 2008** 29  
*50/50 blend of Trajadura and Alvarinho, clocking in at 12% alcohol. Fruity, but mouth puckering, with a lemon-tinged finish on opening, this manages to pull its parts together beautifully to become quite charming.*
- Chateau Revelette Rose // Coteaux d'Aix-en-Provence, France 2009** 40  
*Tinge of spice upfront that leads to intense flavors of red fruit confit and ginger. Finishes crisp, with a snap of glazed citrus. 87 WS..*
- Delheim Gewurztraminer // Simonsberg-Stellenbosch, South Africa 2008** 40  
*Soft and forward, with tasty lemon peel, grapefruit and kiwifruit notes that linger on the easygoing finish. Lightly sweet.*
- V. Girault Clos de Volagre Chenin Blanc // Montlouis-sur-Loire, France 2008** 50  
*Biodynamic-grown. This Chenin has very nice acidity and a great sweetness. A perfect match for white fish.*
- Weingut Brundlmayer Grüner Veltliner // Langenlois, Austria 2007** 68  
*An irresistible Grüner showing some effervescence. A gentle balance of fruit, melon, and minerality.*
- Domaine de Lancyre Vin de Pays // Montferrand, France 2007** 68  
*Dense yet juicy, refreshing palate featuring salt and pepper-dusted melon and citrus. Roussanne. 90 Parker*
- E. Guigal Hermitage Blanc // Northern Rhone, France 2005** 135  
*Butter, creamed peach, toasted brioche, almond and heather notes that are densely layered on the long finish. 93 WS.*
- Domaine Saint Prefert Blanc // Chateauneuf-du-Pape, France 2009** 135  
*Aromas of waxy rose petals and honeysuckle along with good freshness and minerality, plenty of body, and a honeyed finish. NYR.*

## PINOT NOIR

- Black Dog Cellars, Haney Family Estate // Russian River Valley, California 2007** 50  
*Project of local Nashvillian, Mike Haney. Testament to the lush, full-flavored elegance of the appellation.*
- Martinelli, Three Sisters Vineyard, "Sea Ridge Meadow" // Sonoma Coast, California 2006** 55  
*Scents of pomegranate, kirsch, licorice, and underbrush. It is a full-bodied, silky-textured, sexy, opulent effort. 93 Parker.*
- Calathus // Mendoza, Argentina 2007** 55  
*Black cherry and black raspberry lead to a silky, medium-bodied Pinot. 90 Parker.*
- Tohu // Marlborough, New Zealand 2007** 59  
*Lithe, medium-weight, generous and appealing for the coffee nuances that swirl through the plum and currant fruit. 91 WS.*
